Stormwater Update Workshop – Gary Milbrand, Mike Hiras-JMT, Steve Hovis - Stock and Leader and Marty Siegel-Stock and Leader

York County Phase 3 Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP)

Mr. Milbrand gave an update on the activities of the 2018 WIP group. Stakeholders, limits and goal strategies was discussed. A comparison of 2013 and 2018 loading reduction numbers was presented.

York Township 2018 MS4 Permit & York County Stormwater Consortium Update - Gary Milbrand, Mike Hiras-JMT, Marty Siegel-Stock and Leader

Mr. Milbrand provided an update on the 2018 PaDEP MS4 Permit Notice of Intent(NOI) submission, the York County Stormwater Consortium(YCSC) Pollution Reduction Plan(PRP), needed changes to the PRP and how the Consortium might meet its goals and his concerns and costs of a possible York Township project. Attorney Siegel provided an update of the meetings between PaDEP and the YCSC and a draft of the PADEP PRP comment letter. Mike Hiras provided an update of upcoming changes to the Township Stormwater Ordinance and how the current ordinance applies to the PaDEP 2018 model ordinance.

York County Stormwater Activities - Gary Milbrand, Steve Hovis - Stock and Leader and Marty Siegal - Stock and Leader

Mr. Milbrand provided an update on the County's current efforts to create a County Stormwater Authority, proposed services and how a County Authority could be funded. Risks of not meeting water quality goals were discussed.

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Attorney Siegel provided an update on potential MS4 permit issuance and the possibility of the Township being a Co-permittee with a County Authority.

York Township Stormwater Authority – Mr. Milbrand presented an overview of the MS4 permit requirements, an overview of the services not proposed to be provided by a County Authority, and a current estimate of York Township Stormwater costs. Attorney Steve Hovis provided an overview of the possibility of a York Township Stormwater Authority. The Board authorized the Solicitor to prepare changes for their consideration to the York Township Water and Sewer Authority covenants to include stormwater.

Recruitment and Retention Money for 2nd Quarter – Station 34 Leo Fire Company

On motion of Comm. Jones, seconded by Comm. Kessler, the Board approved to release the Recruitment and Retention money for the 2nd quarter of 2018 for Station 34, Red Lion Fire Company, and to distribute to them their fire insurance funds once received. Vote 5 yes.

Frederick Drive Dallastown School District Parking Issues

Comm. Jones reported that the Dallastown School District implemented a no parking restriction which prohibits students from parking off campus and that on the first day of school there were no students parked on Frederick Drive. He thanked Township staff for providing signage.
