# JULY 2008 YORK TOWNSHIP RECREATION REPORT

### Action Items

- The information requested to determine Partnership applications for Dallastown Soccer Club and York Youth Soccer Club will be presented for the Board to review and make a decision.

### Administrative Items

- Bids were opened for the Park Building renovations on July 1. The Board of Commissioners approved the bids at its July meeting.
- Director attended a Supervisors' Breakfast Seminar sponsored by Wellspan.
- The Fall Field Allocation Meeting was held on July 24.

### Programs

- **SUMMER PLAYGROUND**— Playground camps are going very well and the children have been having a great time. This year we are using Reliance Bus for the field trips and the service has been great. The drivers arrive early and there have been no problem getting to the field trips.
- **VOLUNTEENS**—So far this summer, the Volunteens have completed service projects with The Daily Bread, York City (York Patriot Days), Children's Home of York, York Township Public Works, and the Playground Program. The program will wrap up on Friday, August 15.
- **SPECIALITY CAMPS**—The July 14-18 UK Soccer Camp had 25 children in the Recreation program, 5 in the Nipper program and 3 in the Goalkeeper program. There are 10 children registered for the Art Camp on July 28–August 1 and there are 6 children registered for the Golf Clinic on July 9-24 at Heritage Hills Golf Resort.
- **BOCCE**—The Spring Bocce League finally ended on July 9. The summer bocce league was suppose to begin on Wednesday, July 16, but due to rain it has not started yet.
- **SENIOR STRIDES**—Normally, the seniors take the summer off because of vacations. But this year, they wanted to continue. There 6 participating for another 5 weeks.
- **BOB ROSS STYLE OIL PAINTING**—On Thursday, July 24, there were 4 people who enjoyed learning this style of painting from Rachel Douglas.
- **SUMMER CONCERTS**—On, Tuesday, July 8, the 257<sup>th</sup> Army Band performed in front of 54 people. The band enjoyed cold cuts provided by the American Legion and the performance was excellent. The 307<sup>th</sup> Army Band was rained out on Sunday, July 13.
- **REHOBOTH BEACH BUS TRIP**—On Saturday, July 19, there were 20 people going to shop and enjoy the beach and sand!! This was the first time the department had a beach trip and those who went would like for the Township to offer it again.
- **THE BIG YARD SALE**—The Big Yard Sale will be held on Saturday, August 16 at York Township Park. To date, there are 82 spots reserved for the event. The event in held in partnership with the York Township Lion's Club
- **FREE FRIDAY NIGHT FLICKS**—The movies started on July 11 and we have had about 200-300 people attending each night. This continues to be one of the most popular summer programs.
- **KEYSTONE GAMES**—The department continued to assist the Keystone Summer Games through the field rental and preparation for baseball games on McWilliams Field at York Township Park. Games were held from Tuesday, July 22 through Sunday, July 27.
