Administrative Items

- Met with Stump property owners at their residence to obtain signatures for subdivision plan on October 10.
- Met with Gametime representative onsite at Heritage Hills Park to discuss playground placement on October 11.
- Attended York Township Planning Commission meeting on October 16 for action on Stump subdivision plan.
- Attended York Township EAC meeting on October 17.
- Met with architect at York Township Park Building on October 23 to discuss renovations.
- Presented update on Ma & Pa Community Greenway project to the York Area Council of Governments on October 25.
- Represented Recreation Department at the October 29 budget hearing.

Programs

- **New York City Bus Trip**—After a few days of clouds and rain the weather was perfect for a trip to New York City on Saturday, October 20. This trip has become the prequel to the department's New York City holiday trips.
- **Fitness Classes**—The last week of October completes Session 1 of classes. Current participants have expressed an interest in continuing classes for Session 2. The Mat Pilates class has 5 people registered and the class will begin on Monday, November 5.
- **Touch-A-Truck**—This event was part of last year's Open House and, because of its popularity, is now among the department's annual events. On Saturday, October 13, trucks of all sizes were climbed on, honked and enjoyed by ALL ages at the Township Building. Children were amazed by the ladder from the fire truck and excited to board a Red Lion Charter bus. Parents asked many questions about the mechanical arm on the recycle truck of York Waste, children climbed up the ladder of the cement mixer, and later sat in the driver's seat of the tow truck. The children loved receiving trinkets from Shipley Oil's truck driver and they loved bouncing in the Bounce House to end their day. This is definitely an event the department will continue and look forward to as much as those parents who left messages expressing their appreciation.
- **Halloween Carnival**—On Friday, October 26 at Ore Valley Elementary School Gym, there were approximately 400 parents and children attending the annual Halloween Carnival. This event continues to grow every year and is a success due to the businesses such as Rutter's Dairy, Frito Lay, Stauffer's Biscuit Company, and Brown's Market for their donations and the Dallastown High School Volunteer Club for helping decorate as well as assist with the games.
- **AARP Safe Driver Class**—There were 12 participants attending this class on Monday, October 22 and Wednesday, October 24. This was the last session for this year and dates have already been scheduled for 2008.
