- Met with Public Works to review trail paving project and future capital improvements at York Township Park.
- Prepared job descriptions for full-time positions within department and a recreation supplement to be included when applicable for York Township Employment Application.
- Director and Program Director attended rental meeting on September 4 for Dallastown Area School District facilities.
- Attended York Township Planning Commission meeting on September 18 for review on Stump and Markey projects.
- Attended York Township EAC meeting on September 19 and reviewed Mill Creek Preserve progress.
- Assessed Heritage Hills Park playground for new playground equipment and possible moving of playground site to new area in the park (near the basketball courts).
- Attended National Recreation and Park Association Congress September 24-28.
- Prepared Sports Partnership Agreement for review by the Recreation Board.
- Prepared department's 2007 end of year projected budget for Finance Director.
- Approved improvement project submitted by the Dallastown American Legion for a deck near the concession stand at Shryock Field.

### Programs

- **York Township Girls' Softball**—The York Township 12U Storm team is blowing the other teams away. Even though teams are not required to keep record of wins or losses for Fall Ball, the Storm is doing very well and have won 5 of their 6 home games. The girls will be traveling for the next 3 weekends, so wish them luck!!
- **Fitness Classes**—New sessions for classes began the last week in September. The Senior Strides Interval Training class meets on Mondays and Wednesdays and it has ten participants. Out of those attending we have four new participants. This class has been very popular and the seniors are very dedicated to their exercise program. On Tuesday & Thursdays the department is offering an Interval Step class and it has eight participants. There are five new participants and three returning participants. The Monday, Pilates and Wednesday, FitBall class did not have enough participants registered. Now that classes have begun I've had more phone calls about the Mat Pilates class.
